

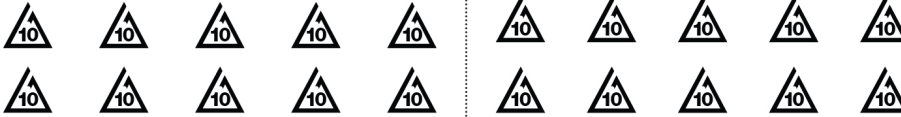

Respect for ourselves guides our morals, respect for others guides our manners. Respect isn't asked for, it's earned.



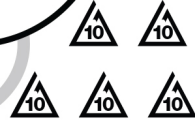
Start here!
